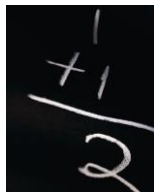


Year 1 Newsletter January 2019

In RE we will learn that Christians believe that God made the world and that everything in it is important to God.



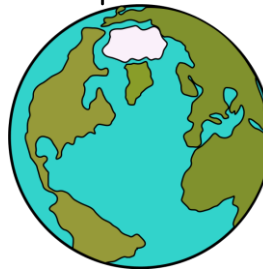
In Geography we will be finding out about the countries of the UK and using geographical language to describe them. Also we will learn about the continents and major oceans of the world.
