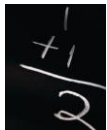


## Year 1 Newsletter February 2019

In Literacy we shall be writing labels and lists. Also we will have a go at writing recounts and information texts. The children will bring home weekly spellings to learn each Friday for a test the following Thursday.



In Numeracy we will introduce simple multiplication and division in a very practical way. We will start work on fractions (halves and quarters) and have a go at describing turns, including whole, half and quarter turns.

In ICT we will be using computer simulations to support our topic work. We will continue our work on simple coding.
