Literacy (Reading and Writing)

**Blend and segment cvc words **Link sounds to letters— naming and sounding letters of the alphabet **Use clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning **write first and second name forming each sound correctly **Attempt to write a simple sentence **Read words and simple sentences **Read



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

**Play in groups, extending and elaborating ideas **Initiate conversation and take into account what others say **Understands that own actions affect others **Takes steps to resolve conflicts with other children, e.g. finding a compromise Beginning to be able to negotiate and solve problems without aggression e.g. when someone has taken their toy



Mathematics (Number - Shape and Space)

**Count reliably to 20, putting numbers in the correct order, saying which is more than and less than **Add and subtract two single digit numbers **Order two or three items by length, height, weight or capacity **Measure short periods



Expressive Arts and Design / Being Imaginative

**Experiments to create different textures **Selects appropriate tools and adapts work where necessary **Safely use and explore a variety of materials They represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories
