Literacy (Reading and Writing)

**Read and understand simple sentences **Use your phonic knowledge to decode regular words **Read and write some common irregular words **Talk to others about what you have read **Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sound **Write some simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

**Take into account one another's ideas about how to organise an activity **Show sensitivity to others' needs and form positive relationships **Confident to try new activities and speak in a familiar group **Talk about how you can show feelings **Understand that some behaviour is unacceptable **Follow the class always rules



Mathematics (Number - Shape and Space)

**Count to 20 and place them in order **Say one more and one less than a given number **Use objects to add and subtract two single-digit numbers **Solve problems involving doubling, halving and sharing **Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance time and money to solve problems



Expressive Arts and Design / Being Imaginative

**Sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them **Use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques **Experiment with colour and design **Represent your own ideas, thoughts and feelings through, art, music, dance, role play and stories
