Literacy and Maths

Reading and Writing – Writing opportunities will be linked to topics and the children will write for different purposes. This half term they will be covering a non-chronological report, persuasive writing, narrative and newspaper report. Daily phonics and spelling sessions will be taking place alongside daily reading.

Maths – This half term we will be focusing on multiplication & division, fractions of amounts and shapes and statistics. Year 2 will be working on their times tables and division facts for 2x, 5x and 10x.

Topics

Week 1 & 2: Italy

In this Geography topic, Year 2 will be learning about the Italian cultures and knowing what Italy looks like on a map. Year 2 compare Italy with another country and recognise landmarks.

Week 3 & 4: Titanic

This History topic is based on the events of the Titanic and the cause of the Titanic disaster. Year 2 will use sources to learn about the Titanic and compare first and third class.

Week 5 & 6: Feelings

Year 2 will be understanding the importance of being aware of other's feelings and their thoughts on moving on into Key Stage Two throughout this RSE topic.

Religious Education

This half term our Christian Value is Trust. Year 2 have weekly RE sessions looking at a range of bible stories and parables including the spread of Christianity in the Gospels.

Physical Education

In PE this half term, Year 2 will be taking part in OAA (Outdoor Activity Adventures) and Rounders.

Computing

In computing children will be continuing to work on working safely on the internet. Year 2 will be looking at researching and word processing at a higher level through their topic learning.

Home Learning and Other Relevant Information

In Year 2 we;

- Complete any activity from the 9 areas of the Year 2 homework grid
- Reading – please write in the planner to indicate when your child has read and bring their reading book every day.
- Weekly spellings – given out on a Monday
- Homework – one piece of learning to be given out every Friday and to be returned by the following Wednesday.
- Library visits are fortnightly on Wednesday – please return library books.
- PE is every Wednesday and Friday – children come to school in their PE kits on these days.
