### Literacy and Maths

In Literacy we will continue to work towards the non-negotiables throughout our Year 4 topics. Writing narratives and non-narratives will be linked to each topic below and children will produce work for a variety of different purposes, such as Treasure Island linked to our geography topic. We will also be creating a biography on The Beatles.

In Numeracy, we will continue to work on shapes looking at polygons and symmetry. We will also be looking at statistics drawing and interpreting graphs and charts. We will also focus on proportion and direction looking at coordinates and translations.

### Topics

#### Week 1 & 2: Geography, Show me the way home.

During this topic we will be looking at maps to identify locations in countries in Europe including Russia. Identify some human and physical features in countries in Europe. We will be looking at the geographical regions in the UK.

#### Week 3 & 4: Music, The Beatles.

During this topic, we will look at notations to record and interpret it pitch. Identify characters in a piece of music. The children will be also composing music to create mood.

#### Week 5 & 6: R.E, are all church is the same?

During this topic, we will be comparing different churches from many different religions. We will also be looking at Christianity around the world.
